

How to Incorporate Eggrock into Your Project

The purpose of this paper is to explain how Eggrock fits into your project plan so that your project goes smoothly. The following steps have shown to be very effective over many installations.

Step	Details
1. Determine if Eggrock is right for your project.	Review Eggrock’s guide titled, “A Hotel Owner’s Guide to Evaluating the Cost of Eggrock Bathrooms”. Review Eggrock’s web site www.eggrock.com . Once you understand the cost/benefit of using Eggrock you can make an informed decision about moving forward. 2. Speak to an Eggrock Project Consultant	Eggrock will send you an information kit further detailing our products. Our project consultant will review your specific needs and questions with you over the phone.
3. Obtain Pricing	Your quotation will include pricing for a brand standard bathroom including brand compliant finishes and fixtures.
4. Visit Eggrock Factory	We highly encourage the owner and GC to visit our production facility and meet our team. Customers who do this find it immensely valuable. Based on this discussion we can fine-tune our pricing based on your unique needs.
5. Project Team Training	Eggrock will make a web-based presentation about its product to your project team. This ensures everyone is on the same page about using our system.
6. Sign Contract & Submit Deposit	Eggrock provides a standard contract. Because we are not building on-site and do not provide site labor we do not require AIA contracts. The basic terms of our contract are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 20% deposit • Invoice upon manufacture • Payment required in 20 days • 45 days free storage

7. Approve Final Drawings	<p>The customer's architect will incorporate Eggrock's bathroom into their final drawings. Eggrock provides drawings in CAD format to make it easy. Refer to our guide titled, "How to Bid your Project with Eggrock Pre-Built Bathrooms" for more information. Eggrock also submits shop drawings for the customer to approve prior to manufacturing.</p>
8. Inspect First Unit	<p>Eggrock offers the customer the opportunity to review the first units off the production line as a final check against the specifications. The first bathroom serves as a reference unit.</p>
9. Prepare for Delivery	<p>Eggrock provides your general contractor with a "Pre-Delivery Checklist" to ensure the site is ready to receive the bathrooms. Eggrock requires the signed checklist to be returned with at least 5 days lead-time before the required delivery.</p>
10. Delivery & Inspection	<p>Eggrock will deliver the bathrooms in the exact sequence required by the general contractor. Eggrock will provide a coring template for the plumber to use to locate the bathroom floor penetrations. Eggrock will provide on-site training at this time.</p>
